SPECIAL MEETING MINUTES
March 27, 2018

The special meeting of the Kettle River City Council was held in the meeting room of City Hall. Tuesday, March 27, 2018.

Members present: Tina Tollgaard, David Lucas, George Klaskin, Jason Montgomery, Kris Miller.

Meeting was call to order at 6:30 pm.

The purpose of this Special Meeting was to pass a resolution to apply to the Department of Natural Resources a grant to install a boardwalk. The purposed boardwalk would provide pedestrian traffic from the center of town to the baseball field. Submitted maps showed the location of the proposed boardwalk. Estimated costs were \$20-\$35 per linear foot. The grant would cover 75% and the City 25% of the cost.

The mayor suggested that it could be checked into to get donations from various organizations, such as North Pine Riders or Operation Round-Up. Discussion continued on costs of upkeep and maintenance or the boardwalk.

A motion by Mayor Klaskin to proceed with the application for a grant from the Department of Natural Resources. Seconded by Jason Montgomery. Dave Lucas voted against proceeding with the application for a grant from the Department of Natural Resources..

Mayor Klaskin made a motion and seconded by Jason Montgomery to adjourn the meeting at 6:50 pm.
